




Strategic Research & Innovation Agenda (SRIA)



Partnership on Raw Materials for the Green and Digital Transition RAMP

- RAMP: Co-funded EU Funding Scheme for Research & Innovation (R&I) Projects
- Current partner contribution of €270M EUR and requested EU contribution of €116M, i.e. 30% co-funding rate.
- Total €386M volume exceeds the initial EU estimate (€300M) by far.
- Consortium composed of mainly national/regional Research Funding Organisations
- Duration of 11 years total for fully implementing seven calls and projects), starting early 2026, ending 2037

Vision and objectives



The RAMP quadruple-helix (industry-academia-government-civil society) approach for R&I within the context of collaboration opportunities with the wider RM ecosystem and relevant stakeholders, partnerships and funding schemes.

Expected Results and Impact



- >140 R&I projects involving academia, industry, and other stakeholders.
- Outputs: new knowledge, patents, prototypes, and policy/industry-relevant insights.
- Six annual conferences plus workshops, forums, and dissemination products.
- Enhanced access to RM, more efficient and sustainable processes, circularity across the value chain.
- Durable network fostering scientific, societal, and economic impacts.
- Actions supporting innovation, deployment, public trust, and policy development.

Approach and activities




- RAMP will expand on ERA-MIN efforts with >500% increased funding and broader R&I scope.
- Launch 7 Joint Transnational Calls (JTCs) over a total partnership duration of 11 years.
- Programme organized around six key themes from the RAMP Strategic Research & Innovation Agenda.
- Additional activities: Interdisciplinarity, integration with ongoing initiatives, policy support, annual conferences etc.

Partnership timeline



Timeline:

- Q4 2025 & Q1 2026 > development and preparation of the first Joint Traproposals
- Q1 & Q2 of 2026 > Grant Agreement signature and Partnership launch
- Q2 2026 > Launch of first Joint Transnational EU co-funded Call for Proposals
- Q2 2027 > Communication of results of the call
- Q3 & Q4 of 2027 > Start of selected R&I funded projects
- 2027 and beyond > annual call cycles and additional activities
