Build a strong, international R&I ecosystem on raw materials



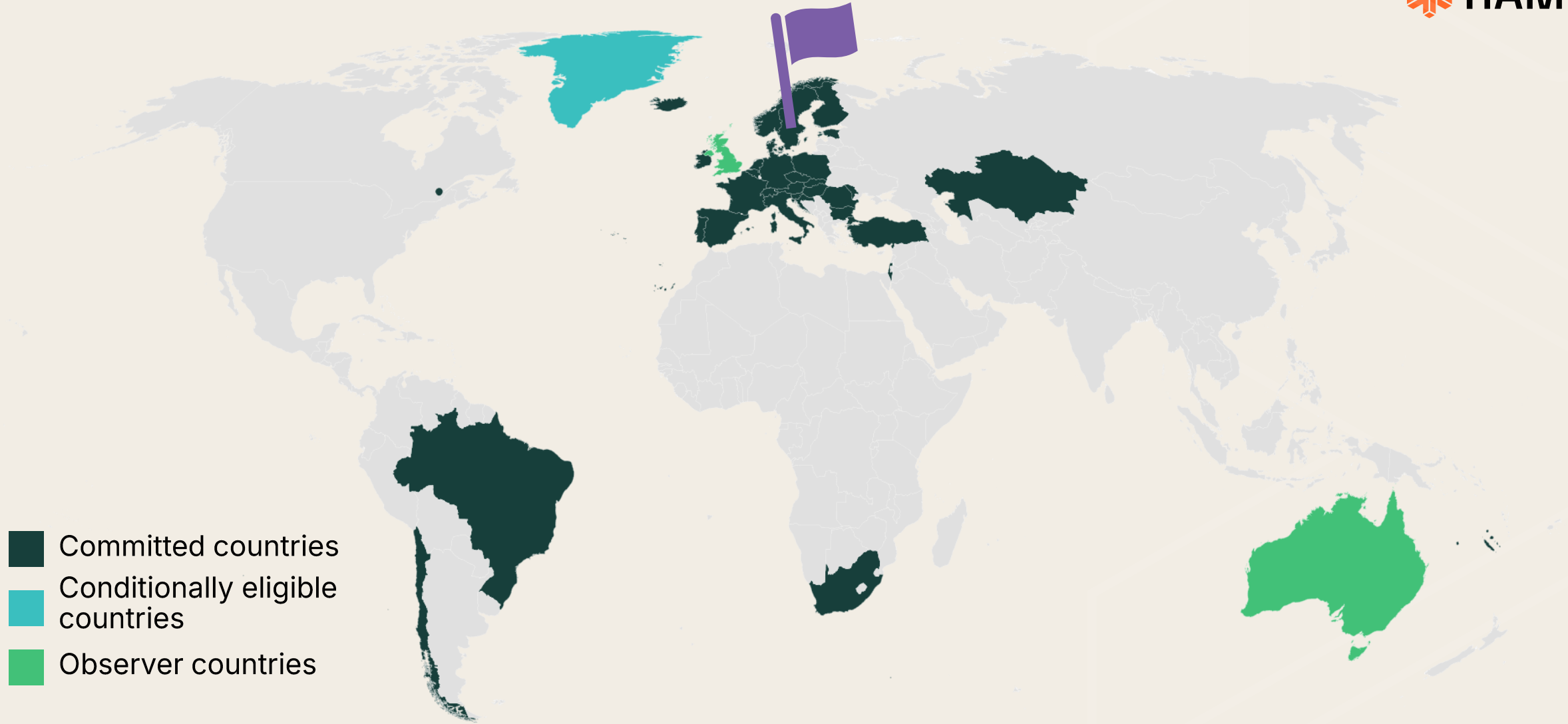

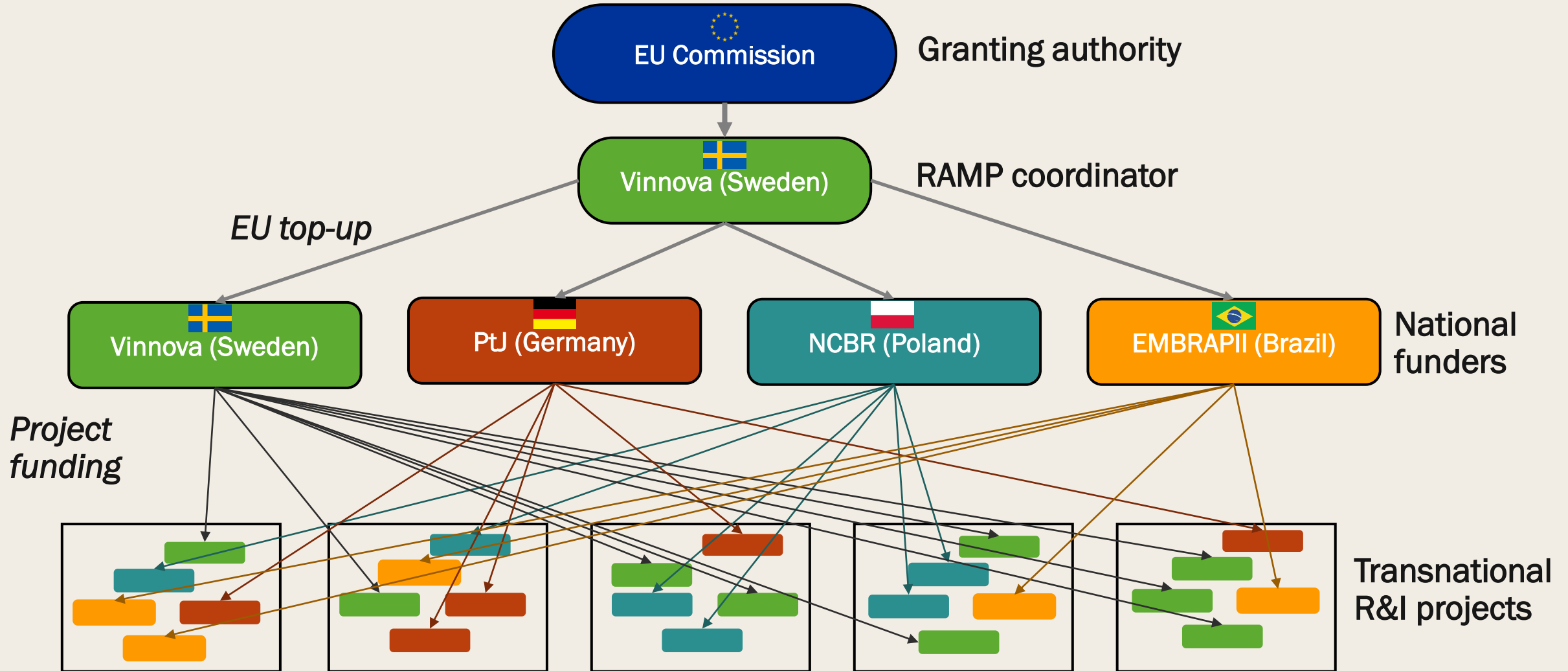

# RAMP joint calls

- Seven annual calls planned (2026–2032)
- Minimum 3 partners from 3 participating countries/regions
- At least 2 partners from EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries
- Eligible applicants include universities, research organisations, companies, public actors and NGOs
- Project duration: up to 36 months

## EU Member States

**Committed:** Austria, Belgium (Wallonia/Wallonia-Brussels Federation), Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany (incl. Saxony), Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden.

**Conditionally eligible:** Greenland (via Denmark).

**Pending confirmation:** Netherlands, Poland, Slovenia.

## Associated countries

**Committed:** Israel, Norway, Québec (Canada), Switzerland, Türkiye.

**Pending confirmation:** Moldova.

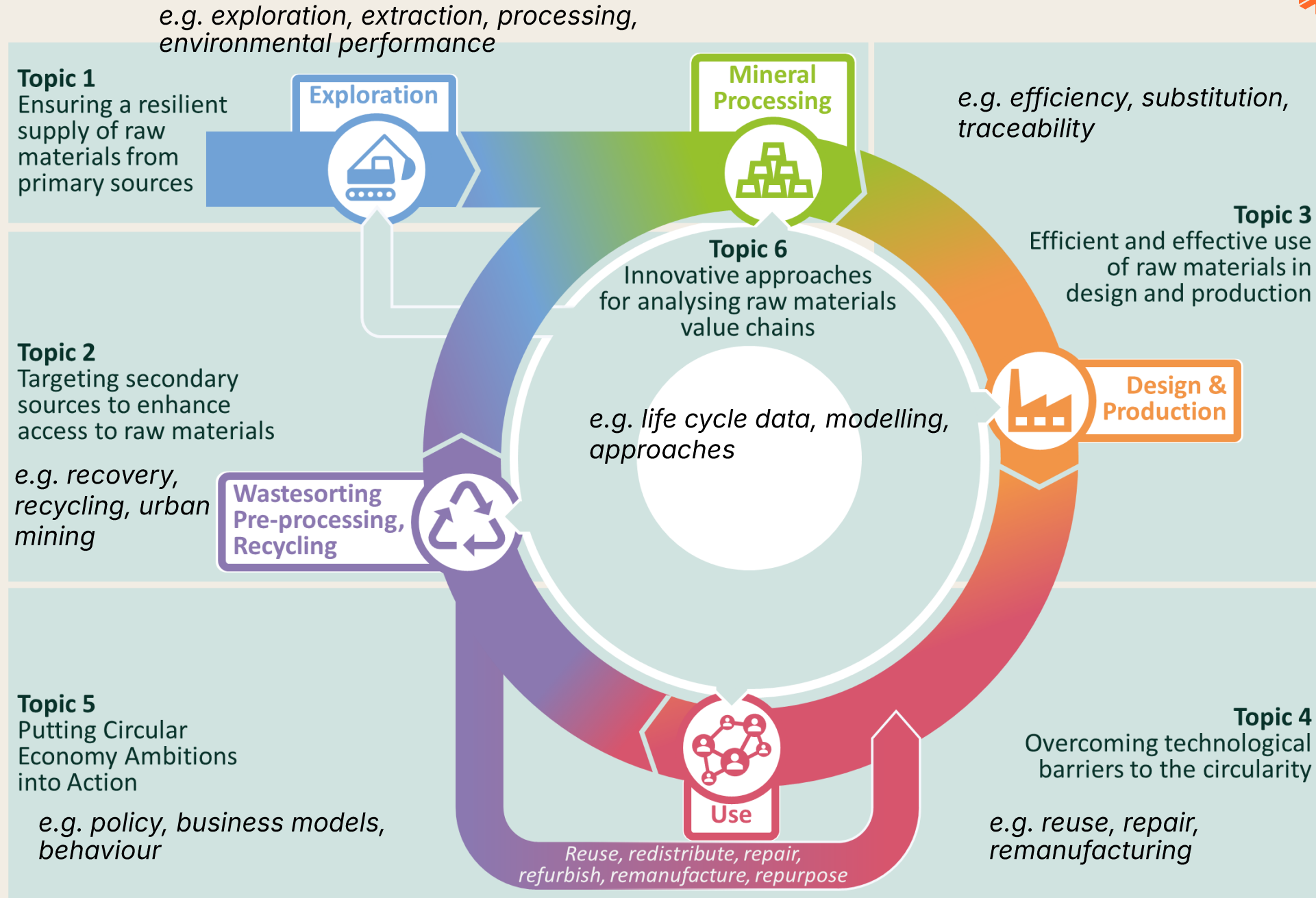
## Third countries

**Committed:** Brazil, New Caledonia.

**Pending confirmation:** Chile.

## Key features

- First Joint Transnational Call under RAMP
- International research and innovation projects across the raw materials value chain
- Indicative total budget: more than €29 million (> €4 million from Swedish funders)
- 6 topics (applicants need to choose one)
- Two-stage application process: pre-proposal and full proposal
- Co-funded by the European Union under Horizon Europe



## Indicative timeline

- Call launch: late June 2026
- Information webinars: early July 2026
- Pre-proposal deadline: late September 2026
- Invitation to submit a full proposal: mid-December 2026
- Full proposal deadline: mid-February 2027
- Funding recommendations: mid-May 2027
- Expected project start: summer to early autumn 2027
